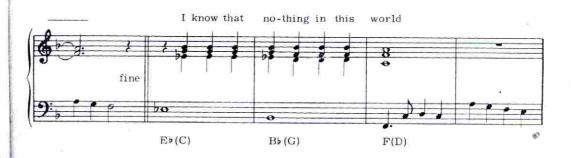
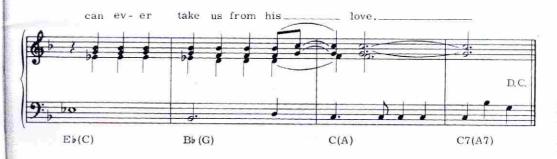
## IF GOD IS FOR US
