

Songs* (Graves), *Madrigali: Six "Firesongs" on Italian Renaissance Poems*,
Cuatro Canciones (Lorca), *A Winter Come* (Moss) and *Lux Aeterna*. His
series of sacred *a cappella* motets, which includes *O Magnum Mysterium*,
have become standard works in the literature and are featured regularly by
distinguished choruses and soloists throughout the world.
